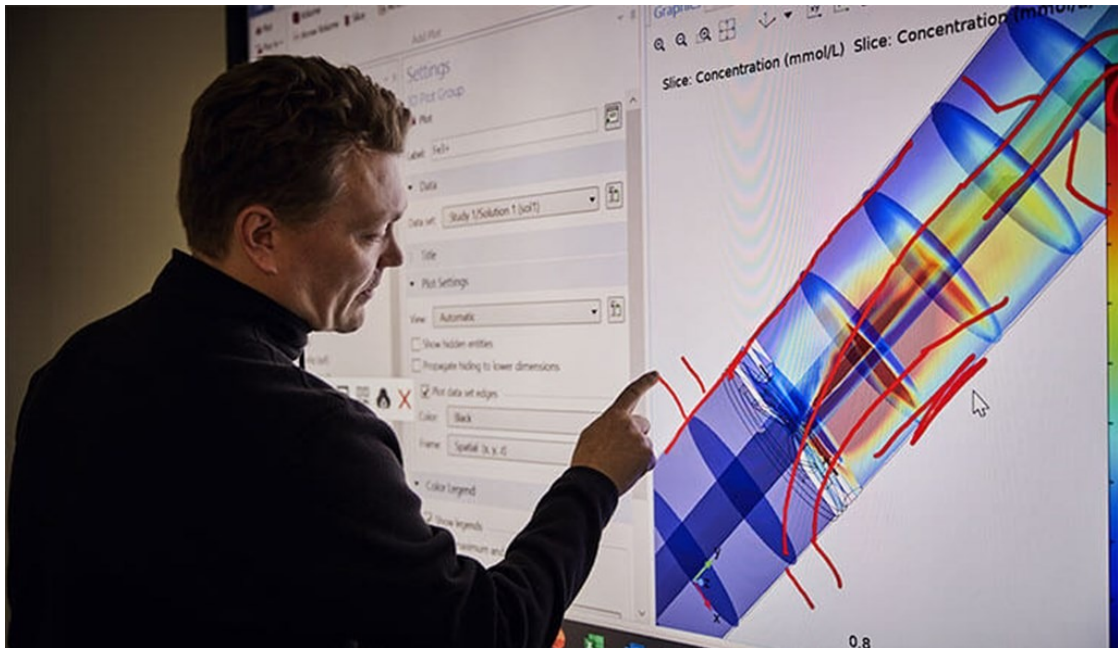
AQUALITY
